Overview of offer

The class of 2026 and alumni postgraduate study offers are intended to support both final year students and alumni by offering discounts and reduced fees to improve access to postgraduate study at Sheffield Hallam. For final year students particularly, this is an incentive to directly progress from UG study to PG study within the Sheffield Hallam community.

Students and alumni who have studied a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate degree, PGCE or PhD at Sheffield Hallam, or a Sheffield Hallam accredited course at a partner institution, are eligible for offers. Home and international students are eligible for the offer. Not all courses are eligible, the full list of eligible courses can be found on the offer page.

This year, students who graduated in both 2025 (last year's completers) and those graduating in 2026 (current final years) are eligible for the higher £2,000 discount for postgraduate courses in 2026/27.

Terms and Conditions

- To access the discount you just need to apply as normal, and the discount will be applied automatically. Some courses may have limited places, so we would encourage applications as soon as possible.
- Students will be entitled to the discount if you have already applied for or accepted an offer on an eligible course (and meet the other eligibility criteria).
- If entry is subsequently deferred to the 2027–28 academic year or later, the discount will not be applied.
- Students will not be eligible for these scholarships if you have only completed a foundation degree, degree apprenticeship or HND programme with us.
- Students who have only undertaken Exchange or Study Abroad, non-awarding programmes at Sheffield Hallam are not eligible.
- Some work experiences routes are included where clearly specified

Please note that standard <u>Postgraduate application deadlines</u> apply for each intake.

Suggested promotional activities

There are lots of helpful ways you can use your networks to share this offer with your students and alumni and generate conversation about postgraduate study routes.

At the end of lectures, particularly those about next steps and careers

We have circulated a powerpoint slide with an overview of the offer that you can add to your lecture presentations or distribute to students via email referencing eligible courses in your subject area. You can specifically mention courses in your department or others that students often progress onto and what this would mean for their career path, employability and earning potential. Showcasing postgraduate student quotes or getting a postgraduate student to do a talk is also beneficial.

You can direct final year students to **book onto a postgraduate open day**. Postgraduate open days usually happen twice a year, once in spring and once in autumn.

They can find extra careers support to help with their transition to work or further study on the <u>Final Year page</u> on MyHallam.

Emails to course society presidents

If you work with course societies in your area you could get in touch with the society present to see if they would use their own channels to help promote the offer to society members.
