Useful information for Incomings Students

Location

In the heart of the Black Forest, 1 hour drive from Stuttgart and Freiburg. Close to France and Switzerland – about 1.5 hrs drive by car.

How to get here:

By Train - Train travelers should travel to Schwenningen (Neckar) station, which is located directly across the street of the main campus of the DHBW. <https://int.bahn.de/en>

By Plane - The nearest airports are Stuttgart ('Flughafen/Airport Stuttgart-Echterdingen', 108km by train) and Zurich ('Airport Zürich', 107 km by train).

By Bus: There is a Flix-Bus station in Schwenningen. On the web-site, the station is called Villingen-Schwenningen. There is a bus from the Airport Stuttgart. <https://www.flixbus.de/>

Costs

- Accommodation cost about 300 – 500 € per month plus a deposit (one or two months' rent)
- Food in cafeteria depending on dish 3 – 5 € per meal
- Living costs about 200 € per month
- Health insurance about 110 € per month for non-EU citizens

Internships

Due to our close cooperation with partner companies, we can arrange attractive internships for undergraduate students in the following areas:

- Banking
- Finance and Accounting
- Taxation
- Business management
- Marketing
- HRM
- Logistics
- Sales
- Computer Science, IT
- Engineering
- Social and health care institutions

Internships can be organized throughout the year, although many companies close during the summer months and do not provide placement. The length of the internship can vary, but most companies prefer interns to stay for at least 3 to 6 months. The minimum German language requirement is level **B2** according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages <http://www.eui.eu/Documents/ServicesAdmin/LanguageCentre/CEF.pdf>

The first contact person for an internship is the international programs coordinator in the international office of the student's home university. Students must be nominated by their university in order to receive placement through us.

An orientation seminar is provided in Villingen-Schwenningen prior to the internship, in which business conduct and culture in Germany is taught. This orientation seminar is mandatory. Excursions are offered to all incoming students during their stay in Germany, and interns are encouraged to participate.

Internship placement, accommodation, orientation programs, excursions and full-time support are provided throughout the length of stay in Germany.

Application Deadlines: If you plan to apply for an internship you should send your application at least **5 months** prior to the first day of your internship
