 - M.A. Development Studies

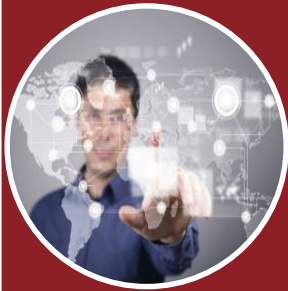

Take classes at our Language Centre

- Foreign languages are part of the study programme or can be integrated additionally
- **Choose from 14 different languages**
(many of them taught up to the highest proficiency level):
 - German as a foreign language, English, French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, Polish, Russian, Czech, Chinese, Indonesian, Thai, Turkish
- **Subject-specific language programmes** in Business & Economics, Law, Cultural Studies, Computer Science and Teacher Education

Many options, at affordable cost

- State-run student halls (in the city, not on campus):
 - monthly rent: 175 – 335 €
 - apply as early as possible, at the latest by 15 June (winter semester) / 15 Decembre (summer semester)
- Independent & commercial student halls
- Shared accommodation and student flats
 - monthly rent: 180 – 400 €
 - usually require a two/three-month deposit when you move in

How much money will I need?

You should budget for €861 per month

- **This amount should cover the following cost:**

rent:	€250-350
groceries:	€150-250
books/other supplies:	€50-100
health insurance:	€80-90

- **Semester contribution (payable twice a year): €74,50**

student services contribution:	€52
semester bus pass:	€22,50

- **There are no tuition fees!**
