Guidelines for the Academic Calendar

The Ca' Foscari Academic Year is divided into **two semesters** for the:


- Department of Environmental Sciences, Informatics and Statistics (DAIS)
- Department of Molecular Sciences and Nanosystems (DSMN)
- Department of Asian and North African Studies (DSAAM)
- Department of Linguistics and Comparative Cultural Studies (DSLCC)

The first semester usually runs from September to January, while the second runs from February to June.

To know whether a course is held during the first semester, you need to follow the following steps. Let's make an example: let's say I want to know when the course <u>LT0090 ROMANCE PHILOLOGY</u> is held. You need to:

- 1. Go to the Course Catalogue;
- 2. Write the course's code in the appropriate space and then click on "search"

3. Then, click on "ROMANCE PHILOLOGY"

4. You'll be redirected to the webpage of the course. Under "PERIOD" you'll see the period in which the course is going to be held.


However, other departments follow a **terms**-based calendar. Each semester is divided into two terms. Consequently, the first semester is divided into **first** and **second term**, while the second semester is divided into **third** and **fourth term**. The departments that follow this structure are:

- Department of Economics (DEC)
- Department of Humanities (DSU)
- Department of Management (DMA)
- Department of Philosophy and Cultural Heritage (DFBC)

Let's say I want to find whether the course <u>ET2001 BUSINESS LAW</u> is held during the first or second term.

- 1. Go to the Course Catalogue
- 2. Write in the appropriate space the code of the course and then click on "search"

3. Then, click on "BUSINESS LAW"

4. You'll be forwarded to the webpage of the course. Under "PERIOD" you'll be able to see the period in which the course is going to be held

If your mobility is for the first semester, then you need to choose among courses held during the <u>FIRST SEMESTER</u> and/or courses held during the <u>FIRST AND SECOND TERMS</u> (see examples above).

If your mobility is for the second semester, then you need to choose among courses held during the <u>SECOND SEMESTER</u> and/or <u>THIRD AND FOURTH TERMS</u> as in the following examples.

The courses that run for a semester have also an **exam session** at the end of each term, and not just in January and end of May-June like the semester-based courses.

Please keep in mind that **modules that are made up by two courses**, which run for two consecutive semester, have a different schedule. For example, the first-term part has an exam session at the end of the term (between October and November), while the **second-term part only has an exam session in January**.

Instead, **standalone second term courses** have an exam session in **December** and the regular one in **January**.
