Language requirements & Romanian language course	Students may enrol in the courses taught in English, French or German language, without taking Romanian language courses.
Levels of studies	Students coming from partner universities may enrol in any course in the undergraduate level and/or postgraduate level, in order to meet the necessary credits at their home institution, upon their return home.
Acceptance letter	For Non-EU members: Upon receiving the complete application file from the foreign students (international office), the CCI will make a formal request for the Ministry of Education and Research to issue an Acceptance Letter (usually taking up to max. 3 weeks to be issued). The CCI will then send via e-mail and post office the copy and original acceptance letter, together with the Certificate of Acceptance issued by UBB (max. 5 days for Europe, max. 3 weeks for the Americas and Asia).

Visa information http://mae.ro/en/foreign-missions	Upon receiving the Acceptance Letter and Certificate of Acceptance, the students will then proceed to apply for the visa (where necessary). *Students should have their return ticket dated prior to the expiration date, or on the expiration date of the visa.
Accommodation	Students from partner universities are accommodated in university dorms. Please note that we don't offer single rooms, only double or triple rooms. The rent is about 50 Euro/month/student, depending on the dormitory. Upon arrival, the students accommodated in the UBB dormitories will have to sign a contract with the dormitory administrator (standard procedure).
Residence permit	All non EU students will have to apply for a resident permit within the first 30 days from their arrival. The resident permit will have to cover their entire stay within the Romanian territory. Members of the EU, EEA countries and the Swiss Confederation will apply for a Certificate of Registration. Information about the application procedure will be given to them by the CCI staff.
Orientation Seminar	During the first week of the semester, incoming students will have the possibility of participating in an orientation seminar, where all the information regarding the mobility and the stay in Cluj will be provided. The date and place will be communicated in time.

Enrolment at UBB	Upon their immediate arrival, the CCI staff will issue requests for enrolment at the faculties the students want to study.
