Or contact the AUAS Immigration team: <a href="mailto:immigration@hva.nl">immigration@hva.nl</a></p> <p>Students need to pay an AUAS visa handling fee of about €200 and need to show <a href="#">the proof of financial means for living expenses</a>: the Dutch Immigration and Naturalisation Service (IND) requires that a student have sufficient financial means to cover their stay in the Netherlands.</p>
