Language of Instruction	 At the Universitat de Girona, most of the subjects are taught in Catalan, but some are taught in Spanish or English, and are open to exchange / mobility students. It is recommended to check the specific language requirements of each Faculty /School. Catalan is the most spoken language at the Universitat de Girona, so the International Office organizes with the Modern Language Services an Introductory course to the Catalan language and culture before the semester starts. The course is free of charge for all the exchange students and they can get 3ECTS.
Traineeships	The mobility of students for Erasmus + for Traineeships is a modality of the Erasmus + program of the European Union. Its purpose is to help students adapt to the demands of the European labor market, acquire specific skills and improve their understanding of the economic and social environment of the country of destination, while acquiring work experience.
