

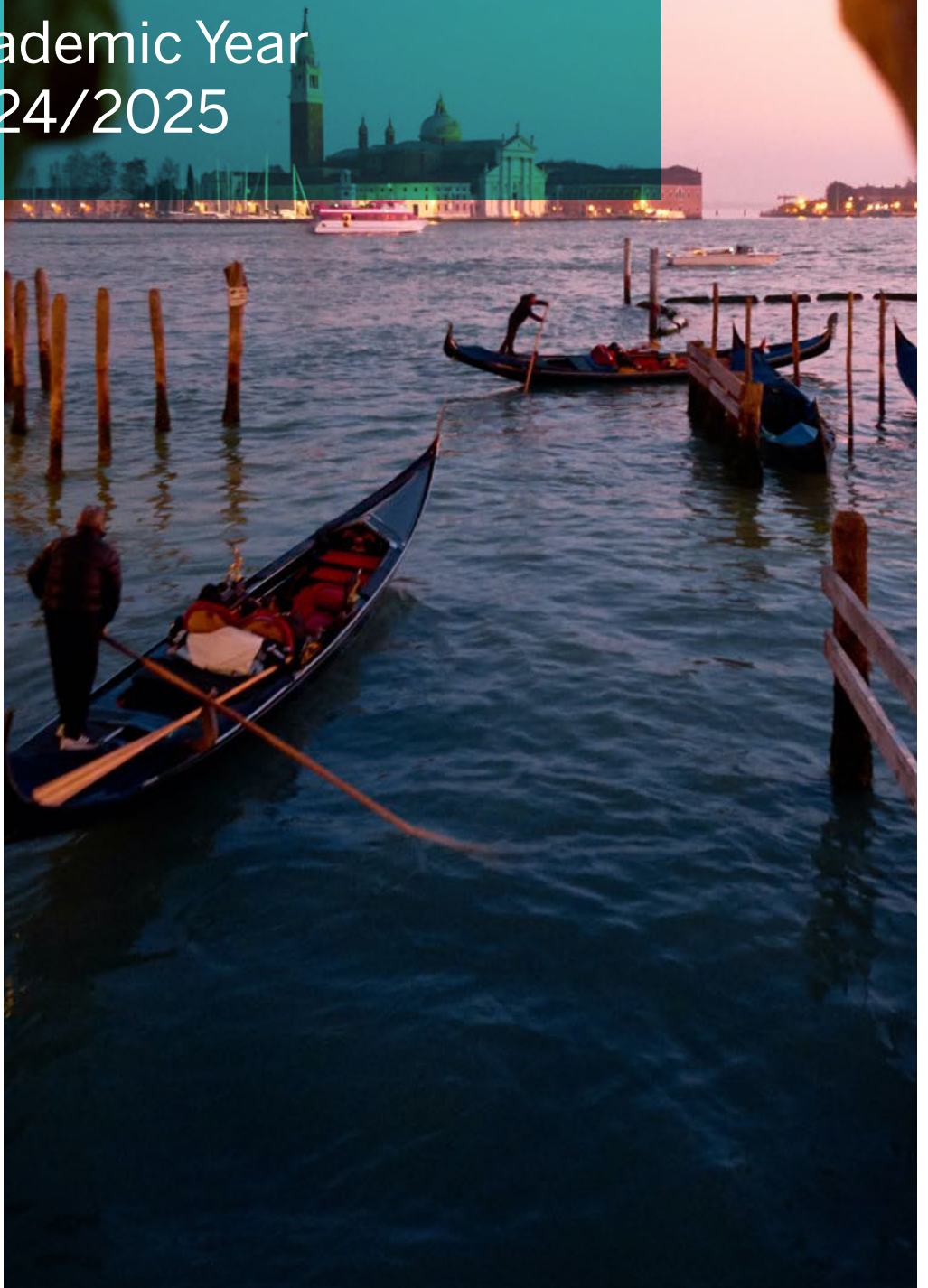

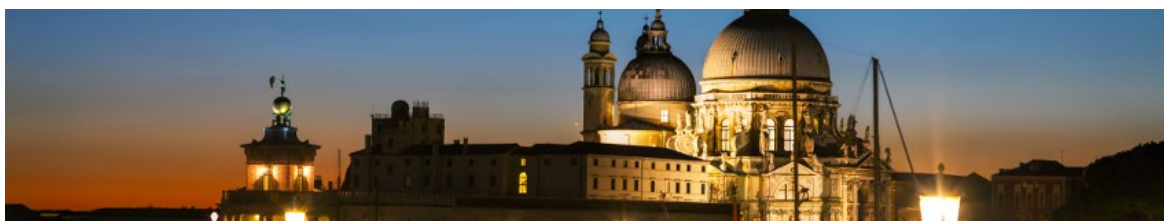

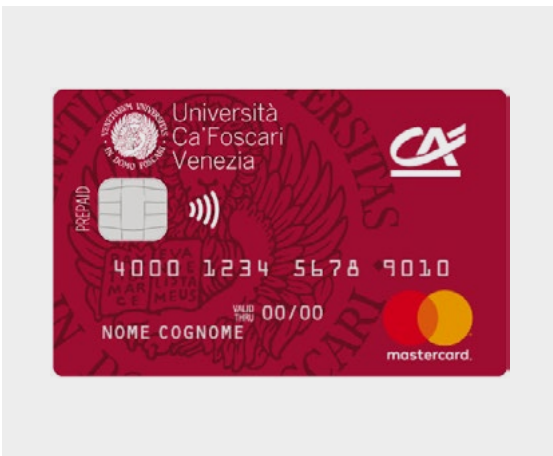
EU citizens

If you are a citizen of a country belonging to the European Union, you do not need a VISA to enter Italy.

Non-EU citizens

If you are a citizen of a country not belonging to the European Union, you need to obtain a VISA for study purposes to arrive in Italy. You should submit your pre-enrolment request by filling in the dedicated online form on the Universitaly portal.

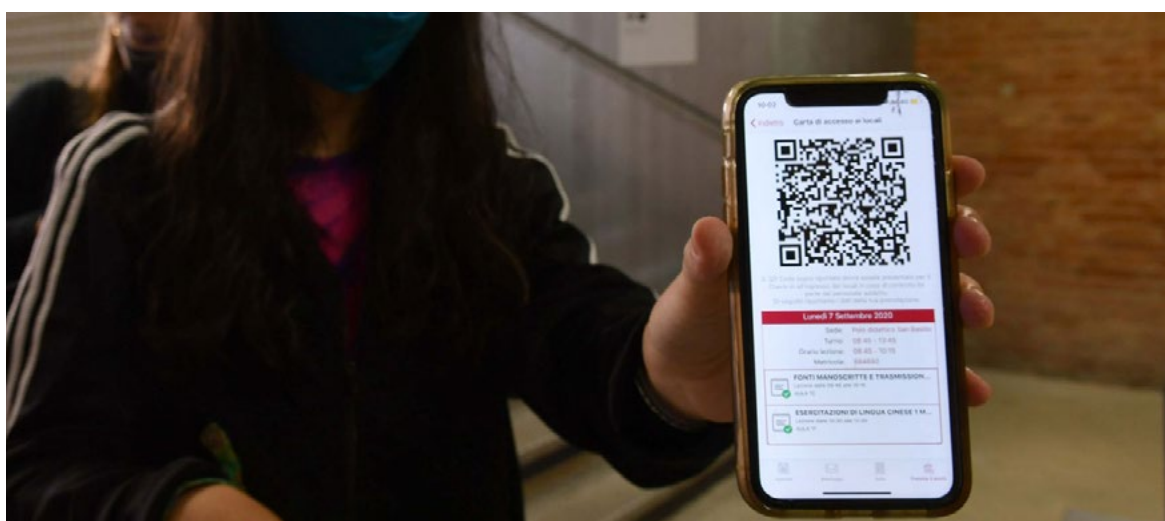

Studying at Ca' Foscari

Academic calendar

At Ca' Foscari the academic year starts in September. The courses in the scientific and humanistic areas are delivered in two semesters.

First semester: September–December

Exams: January

Second semester: February–May

Exams: June

Further academic sessions: end of August – beginning of September

The courses in the economic and management area are delivered into four periods:

First period: mid-September – mid-October

First-period exams: end of October

Second period: November – beginning of December

Second-period exams: mid-December

Winter exam session: January

Third period: February – mid-March

Third-period exams: end of March

Fourth period: April – beginning of May

Fourth-period exams: second half of May

Summer exam session: June

Further academic sessions: end of August – beginning of September



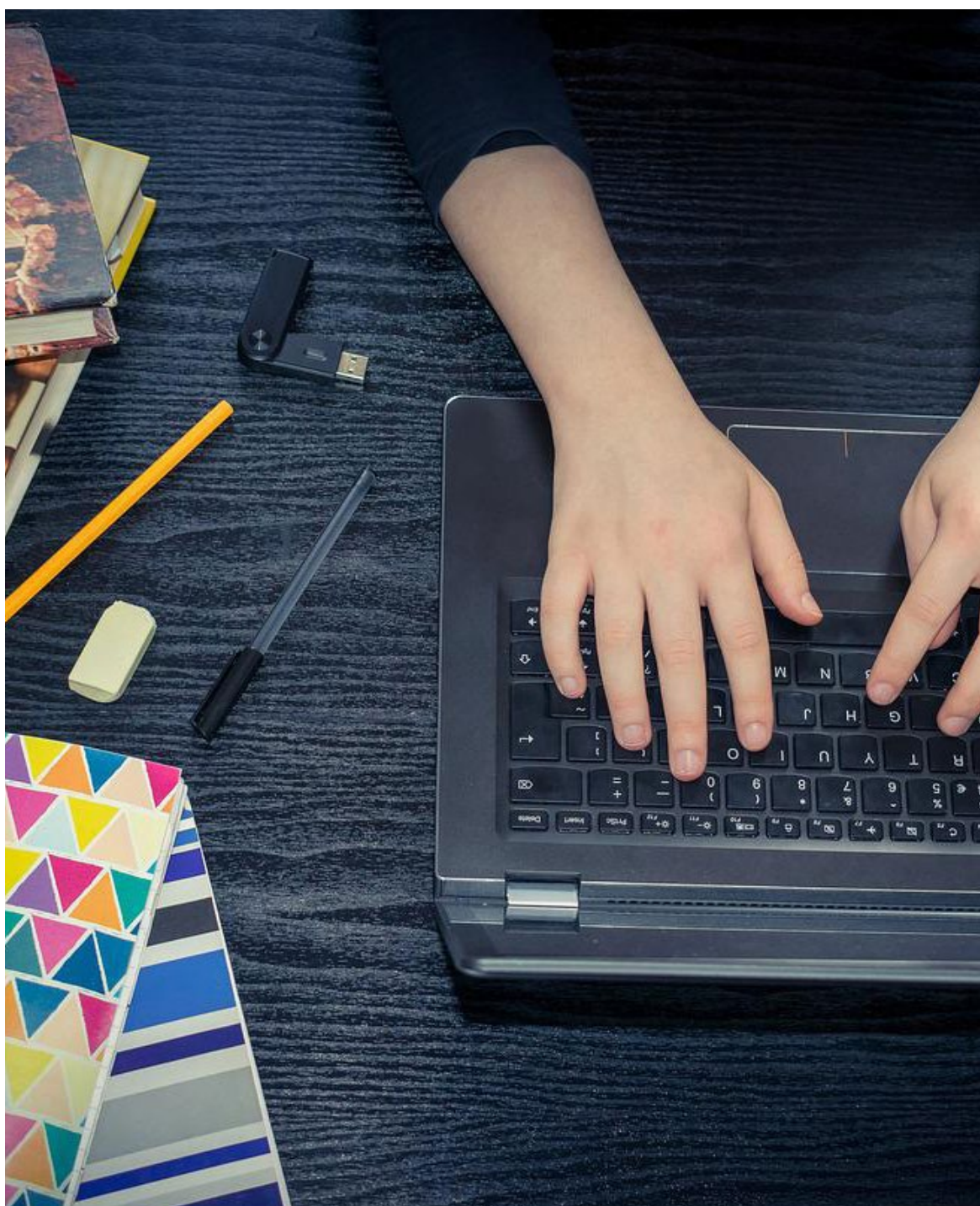
Exams and grades

The Italian grading system works on a scale from 18 to 30. 18 is the lowest passing grade (sufficiency).

30 is the highest grade. In case of particularly outstanding exams, the professor can assign the so-called “lode” and the grade is registered as 30 cum laude (30L). Only if you pass the exam you will obtain the relevant credits (CFU - Crediti Formativi Universitari = ECTS – European Credit Transfer System). Exams usually give 6 or 12 credits.

All passed exams will appear in the Transcript of records issued at the end of your mobility.

Please note: you can only register for exams included in your online booklet.

by airplane

Venice Marco Polo Airport

From Marco Polo airport, you can reach Venice by:

- bus line n. 5 (ACTV) to arrive in the historical center
- bus line no. 15 to arrive in the center of Mestre

- motorboat Alilaguna (by sea)
