	International and sent to all partner institutions.	
Student Visa	Students from non-EU partner institutions must have a student visa to enter Denmark.	
	Cphbusiness International initiate the student visa application and submit ID and password to non-EU students.	
	Non-EU students are required to pay all costs and must complete application for student visa no later than 2 weeks after receiving ID and password.	
	Student visa is process by the Danish Immigration Authorities - SIRI. Cphbusiness does not have access to the student visa application.	
	Communication about student visa must go to SIRI (+45 72 14 20 02). Student case is needed.	
Language of instruction	All teaching is in English. Teaching at Cphbusiness is based on dialogue, group work and presentations.	
	Students MUST have English qualifications corresponding to TOEFL 550 or IELTS 6.0. or Level B2 on Common European	
	Official language tests are not required. However, we expect our partner institutions to ensure that the nominated students' level of English meets the above-mentioned criteria.	
	A student's ability to read, write, speak, and understand English will highly influence the quality of the study abroad period and the student's ability to pass exams.
