
COURSES

ECTS requirement per semester: 15 to 30 ects

Language Requirement: non-native speakers should provide:

- ✓ TOEFL score of 550 or <u>equivalent</u> or the <u>English language certificate</u> attesting to a minimum of B2 according to the Common European Framework for programmes taught in English.
- ✓ B2 French level for programmes taught in French
